




The two tiered system




Adjusted for price increases




State tip credit policies




Six policy scenarios



Tip Credit = MW - TW




Employment growth




Gender matters









Poverty rates

Wrap up

- Growing sector of tipped workers
 - Iow wage, low benefits, high poverty
 - women, less educated & disproportionally young
 - but, 45% are at least 30 years old (33% waiters)
