

TABULATED VOTE ON 40 ASSEMBLY ROLL CALLS

Black ● Indicates a Good Vote. Red ● Indicates a Bad Vote. --- Indicates Absent or Not Voting

Limitations of space permit compilation here of only a limited number of the hundreds of roll calls that directly or indirectly affect the welfare of every member of the American Federation of Labor. The votes listed cover a reasonably wide range of subjects that are of special interest to workers. These particular roll calls were chosen in an effort to give as accurate a picture as possible of the attitude of the various Assemblymen toward a representative list of problems with which Labor is concerned. All roll calls are on final passage of the bill unless otherwise indicated. A more complete analysis of many of the bills shown in this tabulation will be found in text of the report.
