Tabulated Vote on 17 Assembly Roll Calls

Black • Indicates a Good Vote. Red • Indicates a Bad Vote.
—Indicates Absent or Not Voting.
*Indicates a Federation bill.

Limitation of space prevents compilation here of all roll calls affecting the welfare of labor. The votes listed cover a significant range of subjects of special interest to workers. Due to agreements worked out between the interested parties, many bills were passed unanimously, including *AB 3376 and *AB 263,

Table with 17 columns for roll calls (1-17) and rows for 90 Assemblymen (Babbage to Waters) plus a TOTALS row. Each cell contains a vote indicator (black dot for good, red dot for bad, dash for absent) and the roll call number.

The votes of only 79 Assemblymen are used in this tabulation since Assemblyman George R. Butters, who died on April 24, 1951, was not replaced during the session. Assemblyman Butters did not vote on any of these 17 roll calls.
