1 AB 1346—To prohibit alienation in the will and testament of a decedent who has been adjudicated insane, and to provide for the appointment of a guardian of the property of such decedent to make bill special order or business. June 21.
 2 AB 1346—Same. Vote on passage, June 21.
 3 *AB 483—To prohibit "voluntary judgments" in "expressed" contracts with less than 10% owing. June 18.
 4 *AB 483—Same. Vote on Bradley amendments to remove ban on "deficiency judgments" and require only that deficiency actions be taken within four months of liquidation. June 18.
 5 *AB 483—Same. Vote on passage, June 18.
 6 *AB 483—Same. Vote on passage after reconsideration, June 20.
 7 *AB 483—To provide eight-day prior notice on wage attachment. Vote on passage, June 20.
 8 SB 310—To require cross-filing in primary elections. Vote on passage, April 29.
 9 AB 1328—To prohibit amendments in judgments by political bodies making party names unless labeled "unofficial." Vote on passage, June 18.
 10 AB 1328—To liberalize various social welfare programs, including expansion of TANF benefits to families of unemployed. Vote on passage, June 18.
 11 AB 1346—To request for payment of back and compensation taxes on a current basis (part of Governor's tax program). Vote on passage (27 votes required), June 20.
 12 AB 1346—Same. Vote on McCarthy amendments to remove installment payments. June 21.
 13 AB 1346—Same. Vote on passage (27 votes required), June 21.
 14 SB 784—To permit private insurance carriers to select fund. Vote on passage, June 6.
 15 AB 1346—To provide for temporary transfers of funds to state disability insurance fund. Vote on passage, June 21.
